■ Regulations

ATTENTION

We would like to remember you that intra-community (EC) movement of animals, feed and other animal origin materials, are regulated by European laws and regulations, like EC Reg. 1/2005, EEC Directive 90/425 and others.

As consequence, law enforcements (finance, forestry rangers, veterinary health), sometimes are controlling both inside shows, both on the way in Italian road and highway. Most frequent problem is lack of authorization, requirements, and health certificates about transport of animals, feed and other animal origin materials, situations that could be punished with heavy sanctions (money) and with confiscation of animals/goods.

We invite you all to inquire to your official veterinaries (or health system of your country) and providing, if necessary, o regularize your travels, ensuring you'll have not problems during trips and during Italian shows, so to make your trips with peace of mind and security.

Obviously, all those that have complained with requirements and authorization shouldn't fear anything.

RESERVATIONS FOR THE TABLES

To reserve one or more tables at "Verona Reptiles" is needed, to fill out the relative module, with all the personal details and made the payment, **this had to be in advance, for full, no refundable.**

Table dimension **220 cm** length for **70 cm** width.

Each table cost **30 Euro + vat (21%).**

Included with the table are **2 pass for entry as expositor**, each additional pass **will cost € 10** and also this pass will have validity of **the 2 days.**

The layout of the table, and the disposition of them can variate base on technical- logistic needed from the organization.

For the payment of the table, the account info will be communicated by e-mail to the exhibitor as soon as the complete fill out module of registration will be received

The registration has to be consider completed only after the confirmation of the organization, this will happen as soon as the payment will be receive.

From the confirm of reservation, the exhibitor must pay table's cost in 60 days. After this period, tables can be booked by other people.

The organization can refuse booking if there will be **too many exhibitors of the same animals/product**, or also if the exhibitor **made reservation whitout coming (and so, without paying) in the past edictions.** In this cases, we'll notify this decision by e-mail.

OPENING OUR FOR THE EXHIBITORS

Saturday from the 10.00 AM to 20.00 PM open only for the exhibitors and business related persons

Sunday for 7:00 AM

At 20:00 pm of Saturday the building will be close and will be impossible to enter the exhibiting structure before Sunday morning

The organizer reserve **the right to reassigned the reserved table to a third person** if the exhibitor **will not show up before 10 am of Sunday** (9 am o'clock opening to the public)and at that stege any communication hasn't arrive to the organization

The fair will give a plug of **220W for each table.**

The fair will be close at **18:30 pm**, but will still possible to stay in the halls until **20:00 pm** to allow the disassembling of the stand.

OPENING HOURS TO THE PUBLIC

The exhibition will open on **Sunday at 9:00 am** and will end at **18:30 pm**.

LIMITATION AND RULE OF BEHAVIORS

Internal to the V.R. will be possible to **sell exchange small mammals, reptile, amphibians, tree, supply and accessories, and bibliography of the sector**

Birds of any type are not allow to be introduce in the halls.

Any species listed in the **C.I.T.E.S.** (convention of Washington appendix I and II) or in the list related to the **Convenzione di Berna** will have to be peremptory taken with the relative documents.

The exhibited animals will have to be presented in **box of suitable in dimension for the single species**, if the case needed a **supply of drinking water** for species that require it

It's a must a substrate inside each box (wood dust, send, paper, wood chips, aspen, etc.....)

We will not give any fix dimension for what concern the box, we will live this to your good sense, still the animals need to be able to easily move, **and where this is obviously not respected for the tank or box, the organizer keep the right to interfere making the adjustment considered for each situation more opportune** .

All the species exhibited need to be in top condition. Animals sick, or showing bad condition, or with visible symptoms from bad housing will be asked to be taken out of the table immediately, if indication will not be followed the organization week the right to ask the exhibitor to live the fair.

IT'S FORBIDDEN for the exhibitors to leave the show before 18.30 pm.

IT'S FORBIDDEN to make publicity with inserts from fixed position as an example (all' income or in the crossroads between the tables) all' inside of the show

IT'S FORBIDDEN to make photo to the public with animals, specially for cash.

IT'S FORBIDDEN to feed animals with live/death rodents during the show. You can feed lizards and other reptiles only with crickets or other insects.

PRESENTATION OF THE SPECIES

For the exhibit animals is require a label that indicate, **name of the breeder or company name**, the **scientific name**, the **origin** (as place of origin of the specie) and the single indication of **method of reproduction** (CB, CH, WC, ect....)

The accepted indication are:

- **CB:** captive born
- **WC:** wild collected
- **Farm-Raised:** born in original place of origin

It's also appreciate but not a must the indication of the common name (when existing) age (when knew), sex, and the dimension of the species as full adult

For the animals that can realize toxic (for example, snake OPISTOGLIFI, salamanders, toad) it's obligatory indicate toxic on the label.

PROHIBITION AND LIMITATION

It's absolutely prohibited expose, sell, or even introduce in the fair ground, all the species included in the **list of the dangerous animals** indicated by **Decreto Ministeriale del 19-4-1996, 15-5-2001- 03-7-2003**

People that do not respect this rule will be ask to live immediately from the fair

INCLUDED IN THE LIST OF DANGEROUS ANIMALS

REPTILES

- CHELONI (TORTOISE)
 - Macrolemys temminckii (tartaruga alligatore)
 - Mauremys taspica
 - Chelydra serpentina (tartaruga azzannatrice)
- LORICATI (CROCODILE)
 - all the gender, all the species
- SAURI
 - Heloderma ssp (gila monstre)
- VARANI
 - all the gender, all the species
- OFIDI (SNAKES)
 - Boidi -Eunectes murinus (yellow anaconda), Python reticulatus (python retic)
 - Elapidea -all species
 - Viperidae -all species
 - Crotalidae- all species
 - Colubridae - Atractaspis all species ,Thelotornis kirtlandii, Dispholidus typus

ARACNIDI

Having regard to **Decreto Ministeriale 213/2003** in force throughout the Italian territory, **still being revised**, this edition will be forbidden to exhibit, sell, exchange, any species of spiders and scorpions, therefore:

- ARACHNIDA
 - all the gender, all the species
- SCORPIONES
 - all the gender, all the species

VERY IMPORTANT

It is suggested to handle the animals also with the supervision of the breeders, and any way the less as possible

Show with exhibition of person handling animals without a reason, or even worse moving around with snake around the neck, ore any similar behave IT WILL NOT BE TOLLERATE, for respect of the sector and for the safety of the visitors

People not respecting this rules will be immediately expulse from the fair ground.
